

ORDER DESIGNATING OFFICER TO CALCULATE
AND PUBLISH TAX RATES
AND TAKING OTHER ACTIONS IN CONNECTION
WITH THE LEVY OF A TAX FOR 2007

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 132 §

WHEREAS, the chief appraiser of the HCAD has prepared and certified the Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 132 (the "District") tax roll for 2007 to the Tax Assessor and Collector for the District;

WHEREAS, an officer or employee designated by the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the District is required to calculate and publish certain information in accordance with Section 49.236 of the Texas Water Code and the directions of the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas (the "Comptroller");

WHEREAS, the Board must preliminarily decide the 2007 tax rate it proposes to adopt to enable it to publish notice and hold a hearing prior to adopting such tax rate;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 132:

The Board hereby designates Bob Leared, the Tax Assessor and Collector for the District, as its representative to calculate and publish in the form prescribed by the Comptroller all information required by Section 49.236 of the Texas Water Code and the directions of the Comptroller.

At a subsequent meeting, the Board shall consider a proposal to levy an ad valorem tax for the year 2007 at the rate of {\$0.35} per \$100 assessed valuation ~~{(\$0.25)}~~ per \$100 assessed valuation to pay principal and interest to service the District's debts in the next year and {\$0.10} per \$100 assessed valuation to fund maintenance and operating expenditures).

The Board hereby calls a public hearing on the proposed tax rate at 6:00 p.m. on _____, 2007, at The Atascocita Country Club, 20114 Pinehurst, Humble, Texas, a location open to the public, and authorizes and instructs the Tax Assessor and Collector for the District to publish notice of such hearing in accordance with section 49.236 of the Texas Water Code.

The President or the Vice President and Secretary or Assistant Secretary are authorized on behalf of the Board to evidence adoption of this Order and to do any and all things appropriate or necessary to give effect to the intent hereof.
